MUNICIPALITY: Town of Oyster Bay

LOCATION: West End Avenue, Oyster Bay, New York

Project Description:

Laser Industries was awarded this project in October of 2010 and it was completed in July of 2011. An existing parking lot was removed and reconstructed to become a multi-purpose synthetic-turf field. Retaining walls were constructed on three sides of the field to accommodate the existing site amenities. Other work included completely reconstructing two natural-grass baseball fields complete with an under-drain system. Due to the site's proximity to the harbor, tidal water was a constant issue during the installation of the drainage system. Low tide dictated the installation schedule.



Project Elements:

- Bleachers and self-contained underground horizontal perforated pipe storm-water collection system
- Two regulation little league natural-grass fields with storm-water under-drain system
- Dugouts with roofs, bleachers and scoreboard
- Musco sports-lighting system at the multi-purpose field and tennis courts
- Parking lot and pathway lighting
- Perimeter fencing and retaining walls
- Entrance booth, 20' X 40' storage building and 40' octagonal gazebo
- Resurfaced basketball and handball court
- Pre-cast concrete building to contain new electrical service serving the site
- Two parking lots, curbs, sidewalks and drainage
- Stormtech sediment chambers with tidal-check valves
- Bioswale retention area and recharge basin
- Landscaping and irrigation
